#### **Chancellor's Report**

Brothers,

As we prepare to Celebrate Pentecost on May 19, let us reflect on the gifts of the

Holy Spirit. The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit, mentioned by Isaiah, are freely given to us at our baptism. The Catechism notes:

The seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are wisdom, understanding, counsel, fortitude, knowledge, piety, and fear of the Lord. They belong in their fullness to Christ, Son of David. They complete and perfect the virtues of those who receive them. The gifts of the Spirit "complete and perfect" our virtues. When we practice the virtues, we are exerting our minds and wills, with God's help, to grow in goodness and holiness. The Gifts of the Holy Spirit provide inspiration and strength from heaven to help us live out the Virtues expected of us as Knights. Thomas Aquinas notes that human virtues "perfect man according as it is natural for him to be moved by his reason in his interior and exterior actions," while the seven gifts of the Holy Spirit are higher perfections, "not only because they are infused by God, but also because by them man is disposed to Divine inspiration" (Summa Theologiae, Pt. I-II, q. 68, a. I). As a Reminder, please remember to ask good Catholic Men to become part of our Council. It is by our constant invitation to Men to join we will grow our ranks in Service to our Parish and Priests.
